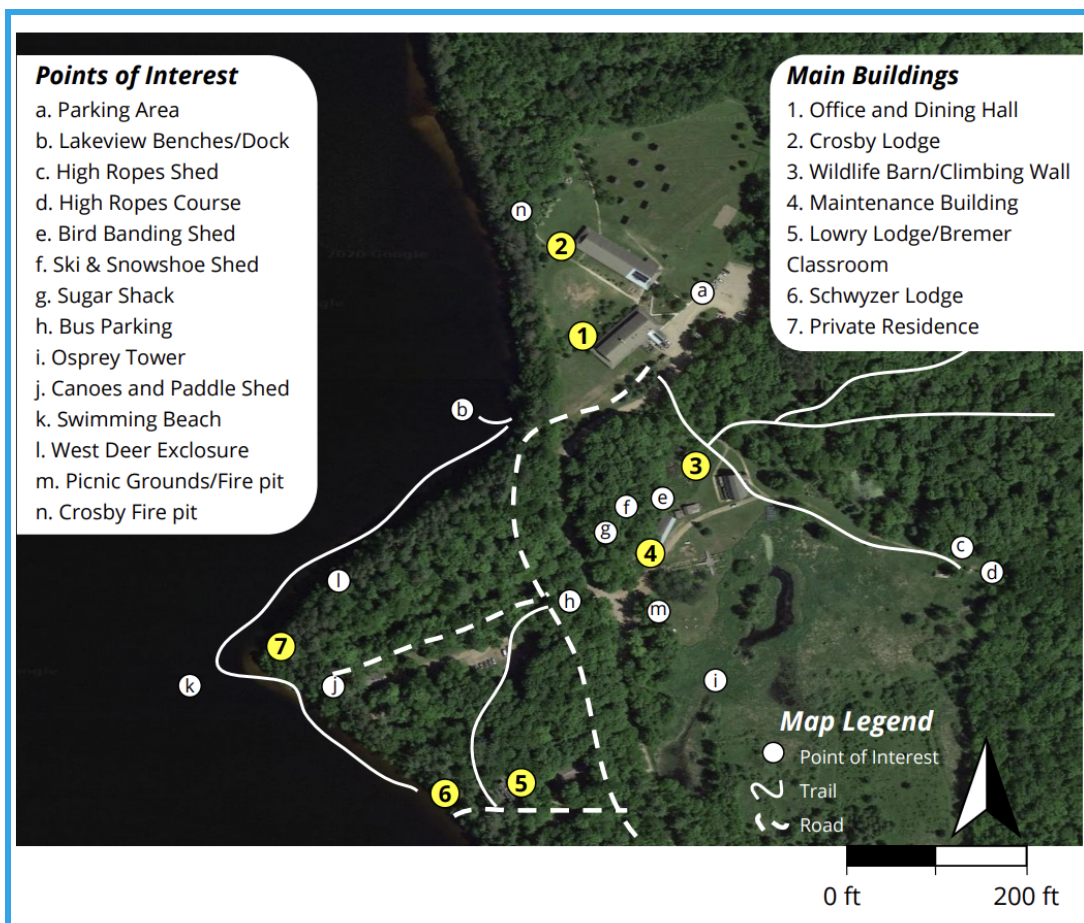

Bedding

Good To Know

Damages

Osprey Wilds checks rooms for cleanliness and damage before and after each group's stay. Anthony and Shelbie will be charged for missing, broken, damaged, or vandalized items, or if extensive cleaning is required. *Miigwech for helping us take care of this beautiful space!*

Wifi - no password required

Food & Meals

Each lodge has a shared kitchen with a refrigerator. **We recommend stopping at a grocery store before arriving** to pick up any snacks, beverages, or lunch items you'd like to have throughout the weekend.

Meals Provided

- **Friday Dinner:** Welcome Party includes dinner.
- **Saturday Breakfast:** Continental breakfast provided. The breakfast items will be available in your lodge's refrigerator.
- **Saturday Lunch:** *On your own.* We recommend bringing easy options like sandwiches. Store food in your lodge's kitchen and fridge.
- **Saturday Dinner:** Dinner will be provided at the wedding reception.
- **Sunday Breakfast:** *On your own.* Checkout is at 10 am.

Swimming & Canoe Launch

The waterfront area located beneath the Staff House is restricted and only available for use during scheduled activities (*see the schedule on the back page for details*). Please note that there is no lifeguard on duty. The water depth increases rapidly, and children must be accompanied by an adult at all times for their safety.

Cell Phone Coverage

Due to our remote location in the Northwoods, cell phone service is often spotty. We recommend not relying solely on mobile devices for making or receiving calls during your stay.

Water

Osprey Wilds operates on a rural well and septic system. Only flush small amounts of toilet paper. The well water is mineral-rich and contains iron, which may give it a distinct taste or scent, though it is perfectly safe to drink. For filtered water, we recommend filling your reusable bottles at the drinking fountains in the Dining Hall, or using the bottled water dispensers provided in each lodge.

When You Arrive

Parking: Lot (A)

Ample, complimentary parking is available in the lot marked (A) on the map. Additional complimentary parking is available in the smaller lots located near your assigned lodge.

Check-In

When: 3:00–6:00 PM on Friday, September 18

*We encourage you to arrive prior 6:00 PM. If you arrive **after 6:00 PM**, you can receive your check-in information at the Welcome Party outside.*

Where: Osprey Wilds Main Office/Dining Hall (Parking Lot A)

What: At check-in, you will complete the [required release form](#). You're also welcome to fill it out before arriving. Then you'll receive your lodge and room assignment.

All individuals staying on site must complete an Osprey Wilds Release Form, NO EXCEPTIONS. Info for form:

Check-Out

When: by 10:00 AM on Sunday, September 20.

What: Before leaving, please help us take care of Osprey Wilds by completing the following.

- Remove all personal belongings from your room and shared spaces.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Turn off all lights and faucets.
- Trash may remain in the designated trash bins.
- If your lodge has a kitchen, please **wash and put away all dishes and cookware.**
- Empty the refrigerators and cabinets. Please remove any food or beverages you brought.

If you are using Osprey Wilds linens:

- Leave all used bed linens piled on top of the bed.
- Leave used towels on the floor. Please **do not place damp towels with the bed linens.**

Other Important Details

Medical & Emergency Information

Please plan accordingly and bring any medications, medical supplies, or other personal health items you may need during your stay. Osprey Wilds staff are certified in CPR and basic first aid, and first aid kits are readily available in each lodge. In the event of a life-threatening emergency, please dial **9-911** (press 9 first to access an outside line) and immediately notify our Guest Contact or an Osprey Wilds staff member. Medical and ambulance services are available approximately 8 miles away in Sandstone. If medical attention is needed but an ambulance is not necessary, guests should arrange transportation using a personal vehicle. Osprey Wilds is unable to provide medical transportation.

A Little Extra Reassurance

We happen to have more than a dozen family medicine physicians joining as guests for the weekend! A physician will be staying in each lodge except Lowry. In the unlikely event of an emergency, there will be plenty of medical knowledge nearby.

Outgoing Calls

Phones for outgoing calls are located in the Blandin Dining Hall and within each lodging building. To access an outside line, please dial **9** first.

Fire Alarm

Should the alarm sound, a single individual must use the on-site radio or telephone to contact the night time liaison **WITHOUT DELAY**. All other guests are required to exit the building and assemble in the parking area. The liaison will arrive at the lodge to silence the alarm, assess the situation for any genuine danger, and contact the fire department or monitoring company as required.

Fire Safety

Guests are responsible for starting and monitoring their own fires. All fires must be attended and fully extinguished before leaving the area.

Sign-up required. Please let Angela know at check-in on Friday if you would like to participate. Limit 18 people. Meet in the courtyard between Crosby Lodge and the Dining Hall. Refer to location D on the map.

10:00 AM–11:00 AM — Farm Tour

No sign-up required. Meet at the gift shop in the Dining Hall. Transportation to the farm requires a short drive; directions will be provided at the meeting point in the gift shop.

12:00–2:00 PM — Lunch on Your Own

3:00 PM — Wedding Ceremony

A note about our Anishinaabe wedding ceremony: Our ceremony will incorporate Anishinaabe traditions that are deeply meaningful to us and our families. We are grateful to share these traditions with you. We ask that guests be present and respectful during the ceremony and follow any guidance provided by our officiant/ceremony leaders.
